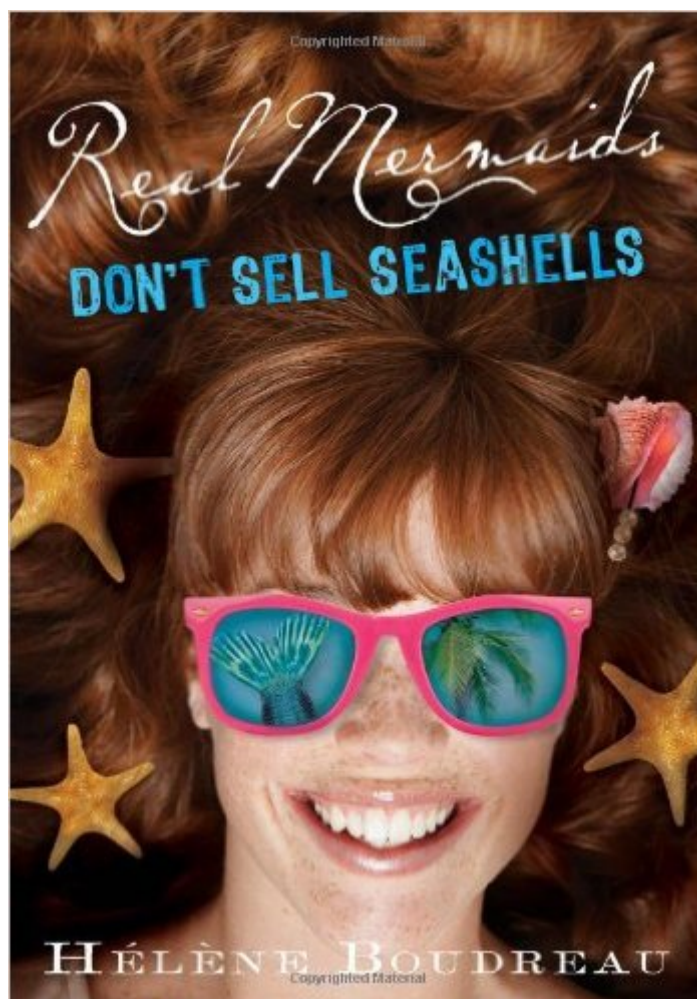


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Real Mermaids Don't Sell Seashells

I found the entire series to be sweet and poignant while having some surprises and twists and turns along the way.
